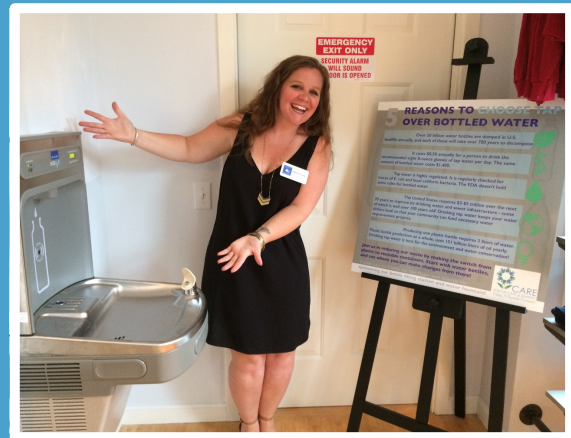


We all share a common interest to keep the Cape a great place to live, work and visit. Here are some ways you can help.
